PASTORAL NOTES AN EXTRA MONTHLY NEWSLETTER

Once a month we hope to produce a newsletter with items relevant only to the whole deanery or pastoral area to which we belong. This aims to develop a sense of awareness of our local parishes, and the mutual support we can give, as well as making available times of Mass/services elsewhere and events of common interest. Bishop Peter has directed these new pastoral areas around the diocese, encouraging us to help each other in whatever we can. He is aware that the number of priests and deacons has diminished and local communities are relying more and more on the different gifts and ministries of their members. This includes, for example, hospital visitors, Eucharistic ministers and lay-led services. Bishop Peter has arranged a visitation of our area, which will include his presence at each of the churches, and at every Mass – in Corby, Kettering Parish, Thrapston/Raunds with Oundle parishes, over the coming months. In our parish this will be 26th/27th November and 10th/11th December.
