PASTORAL TEACHINGS: JUST THE MASS?
There are many helps to our faith outside the Mass, which bring God's presence close to us in daily life. Carrying a rosary with us, perhaps prayed on long train or bus journeys, or just in a pocket or handbag, can be a great reminder of Christ and Mary and the saints with us. Sometimes holy pictures in a book or a crucifix or a statue by our bedside can remind us of God's help in our homes and work. Factory-workers have been known to finger a rosary while on a lonely night-shift. Our baptism name or a new Confirmation name can remind us of a special patron saint whose example can specially speak to us. We can pray to them specially on their feast day. The priests can help identify the dates. Writing this has reminded me of my Confirmation name, Paul, whose main feast is 25th January, but 29th June – with St Peter – is better known. There are sometimes booklets or pamphlets at the back of the Church by the paper table which meet a need. Again, priests may be able to suggest some reading material. Just ask!
