SMALLER CHANGES

At the end of the Readings/Gospel, This is the word of the Lord, This is the Gospel of the Lord, have been shortened to THE WORD OF THE LORD/THE GOSPEL OF THE LORD

THE CREED - For those of us who have never mastered the Creed by heart, a number of small changes have been made. For many years we have said together WE BELIEVE. This was a change from the old Latin CREDO, 'I believe'. It recalled the original statement of faith made in early Councils of the Church; WE BELIEVE, said the Bishops. We had a community feel in repeating the same. Now I BELIEVE will emphasise the individual act of faith. Other items which may strike us in the Creed are speaking of the eternal Son as 'of one being with the Father'. The new translation has chosen a technical term: CONSUBSTANTIAL with the Father.
