PASTORAL NOTES TOUGH MISSIONARIES

As we welcome a Missionary of Africa to speak to us this weekend at St Edward's, we are also reminded of the Church's mission to North America with the feast of Blessed Kateri Tekawitha on 14th July, who lived 1656-1680. She was of the Mohawk tribe, with a deep tradition of physical endurance, very impressed by the manner in which the French Jesuit martyrs endured torture at their end. As we now know certain diseases were brought by Europeans and Kateri's own parents died of small pox, she herself surviving. Harshly brought up, she never forgot the Jesuit missionaries, and eventually found her way north on her own to a Christian settlement and was there able to make her first Holy Communion. Her culture of endurance found an outlet in the penitential practices of the saints, but at the heart was a devotion to Christ present in the Eucharist. We need a certain toughness, as all the saints showed, not being put off by difficulties, spiritual as well as physical – 'keeping our eye on the ball', as a famous cricketer once said! seeing what is important and lasting.
