### KEEP FRIDAYS SPECIAL

From the resolutions of the last Bishops' Conference, 2011. "By the practice of Penance every Catholic identifies with Christ in His death on the cross. We do so in prayer, in fasting, in almsgiving. Every Friday is set aside by the Church as a special day of penance. The Bishops have decided to re-establish the practice that this should be fulfilled by abstaining from meat ..... or from some other food of which a person regularly partakes. Many may wish to go beyond this simple act of common witness and mark each Friday with a time of prayer and self-sacrifice. In these ways we unite our sacrifices to the sacrifice of Christ, who gave up his life for our salvation". (Extract from the Bishops' Statement).
