PASTORAL NOTES

BISHOP'S VISIT TO DEANERY

Bishop Peter came on Tuesday 8th November to speak to the representatives of our local parishes (Pastoral Area). Each church, not only parish, is now represented by two members, so all our own four churches, the three churches of Father Brian (Oundle, Thrapston and Raunds) and the four churches of Corby. The bishop was impressed by how many people turned up (including all the local priests, retired ones too). We were there largely to hear the bishop speak, aware of different needs of different parishes. Bishop Peter was very open to this and made an appointment to return in a year's time. He wanted us to identify and encourage vocations to the priesthood, diaconate and religious life and outline the lay ministries needed in our parishes and how training could take place, and arrange a common spiritual event for next summer. Suggestions, ideas, comments from the wider community are welcome.
