MORE SMALL CHANGES

In the lead up to the Eucharistic Prayer, we have said, IT IS RIGHT TO GIVE HIM THANKS AND PRAISE. Now we will say, IT IS RIGHT AND JUST. In the Holy, holy, the wording has changed from GOD OF POWER AND MIGHT, to GOD OF HOSTS. In the prayer of Consecration, we have, This is the cup of my blood, changed to "the CHALICE of my blood" and in place of 'It will be shed for you and for all, we will read, 'WHICH WILL BE Poured OUT FOR YOU AND FOR MANY'. More literal translations from the Latin have been preferred, as well as reference to Old Testament prophecies. At the same time, Christ's death for all of us and God's universal saving-will are part of our faith and remain so.
