Former Anglicans forming a particular community within the Catholic Church as recently publicised, has to be respected, but does not affect us directly nor the problems we face, but encourages us to pray and work together so as to deepen the faith and understanding of us all. So I do encourage everyone in prayer for Christian Unity this week and for the service next Sunday evening, 6.00pm at SS Peter & Paul, Kettering.
