

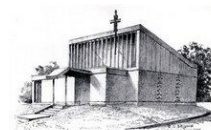
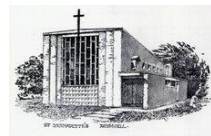

PASTORAL NOTES

MISSION COLLECTION

As we have our appeal for the Association of the Propagation of the Faith (APF-Mill Hill), we remember many men and women missionaries around the world. On 26th June 2011 an Italian missionary was pronounced 'Blessed' Fr Clemente Vismara, a missionary in Burma for more than sixty years. He arrived in Burma in 1923, returning to Italy once only in 1957, because of illness. He worked in the remote area near the borders of China and Thailand – helping to build churches, schools – and, on occasion, extracting teeth! One of his first building-works was an orphanage for 250 children. He trained carpenters and mechanics, introducing new crops and vegetables, living very simply. His companions said, "he died at 91 without ever growing old!" He once said, "Today we have food; tomorrow the Lord will provide". The local bishops called him 'The Patriarch of Burma' (from the Columban FAR EAST magazine).
