PASTORAL TEACHINGS

A Local Saint ?

George Spencer (1799-1864) was the youngest son of the second Earl Spencer of Althorp, Northamptonshire, a family known to us now through Princess Diana. He went to Eton College and Cambridge University, took orders in the Church of England, but increasing doubts led him to become a Catholic. We remember him today because, like saints before and since, he was happy to give up all his prestigious background and become a poor Passionist priest and as Father Ignatius to travel all over England, Ireland and Europe preaching and seeking prayers for England and working simply and respectfully for Christian Unity. His family, unusually for the time, gradually accepted his decision and welcomed him again. He died as humbly as he lived, having a heart attack while walking along a quiet road and dying there alone. He is buried in the Passionist church at Sutton, St Helens. His cause of canonisation was introduced in June 1992.
