PASTORAL TEACHINGS: WHAT IS BENEDICTION?

There are other Church services during the week in many parishes which are regular but rarely known among Catholics, familiar only with the Mass. As we celebrate the feast of Corpus Christi we may remember processions carrying the Blessed Sacrament in a special 'Monstrance', in a way acting out Christ with us on our common pilgrimage through life. But every week there are services where the Blessed Sacrament is exposed on the altar, particularly on a Thursday, in a quiet service where hymns are sung in between times of quiet reflection. On a Sunday we are encouraged to pray some part of the daily round of prayers, mostly psalms and songs from the Bible, which monks and sisters pray together every day. Quite often on a Sunday 'Vespers & Benediction' are combined. 'Vespers' is simply from the Latin for evening, and is the Evening Prayer of psalms and songs. Like a quiet weekday Mass, or time spent in the church on one's own (the church is always open from early morning, say 7.30am, to evening, 7 or even 8pm), such quiet times can be a great benefit in our busy lives. There are also weekly prayer groups.
