**PASTORAL TEACHINGS**  
**THE LORD BE WITH YOU**  
This greeting appears at the beginning of Mass, before the Gospel, at the beginning of the Eucharistic Prayer, and before the final blessing. Rather than AND WITH YOU, the new translation is AND WITH YOUR SPIRIT, a more literal translation of the Latin, used in European countries, which recalls greeting from St Paul's letters. It is to express our unity in the Holy Spirit, with our variety of gifts.  
I CONFESS TO ALMIGHTY GOD. This prayer has been altered considerably, as has the GLORIA, Glory to God in the highest. There is not room here for more detail but prayer-cards are on order for us to use from September.

**The Holy Picture** by the Reading-stand this Sunday is of Father Ignatius Spencer of the famous Northamptonshire family. George was a convert to Catholicism in the early 19<sup>th</sup> century and entered the Passionist Order, taking the name Ignatius (after St Ignatius of Loyola, the founder of the Jesuits – his feast is this Sunday). The cause for the beatification of Ignatius Spencer has been put forward. He worked tirelessly to improve relations between Christians.
